# Descendants of Edward Skipworth of Grimoldby

## *Introduction*

Throughout the nineteenth century, this group of families, descended from Edward Skipworth and Jane Seabright of Grimoldby, have generally remained quite close to their point of origin. It seems that the industrial revolution virtually passed most of them by. Most of the villages mentioned can be found on a map 30 kilometres across.

Apparent inconsistencies have arisen in these and other Skipworth families through individuals changing the way their names are expressed. The order of Christian names may have been reversed, or a second Christian name added, or adopted as the sole name.

There are also apparent inconsistencies in the places of birth as stated in the census returns, particularly when a young person has left home. Either the person filling in the census return was not accurately informed, or the person remembered the place they grew up, not the place of birth.

Transcription errors have crept in, both in compiling the original returns, and in the production of modern indexes. However, unless otherwise indicated in the notes, I am reasonably confident of the identifications because of the relative rarity of the surname and the completeness of the census coverage.

Where the occupation is given as servant this means a live-in employee. It could be a domestic servant in the modern sense, but it could also be a labourer or a trade employee. The original census image will often clarify ambiguous cases.

A note on spelling. Edward Skipwith/Skipworth's life 1716-1759 spanned a period when the surname spelling was particularly fluid. In earlier times Skipwith was the predominant form, with Skipworth an occasional variant. By the end of the century Skipworth was established as the common spelling with Skipwith still occurring occasionally. This is particularly noticeable in the Grimoldby parish registers in the 1750s when both Edward and his brother Thomas were regularly bringing their offspring for baptisms or burials. In some years all the entries are Skipwiths, in other years they are all Skipworths, the choice appearing to depend on the whim of the clerk writing up the Register. For convenience I have adopted the Skipworth spelling throughout this document, regardless of what was used in the sources.

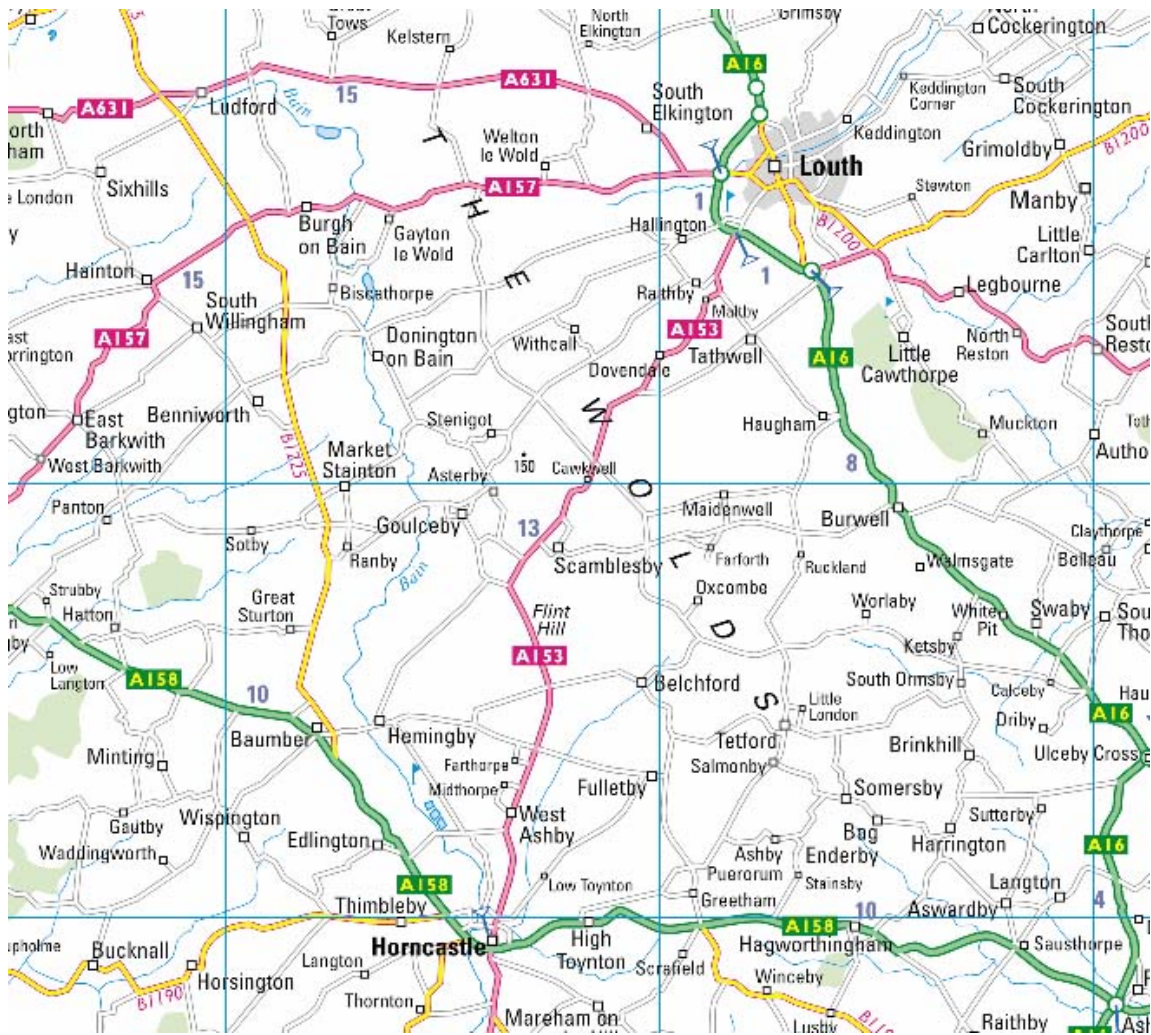
The variant Shipworth appears occasionally, but I am convinced that this is not a genuine surname, simply a recording error. A bigger problem occurs with the recording of some Skipworths as Hepworth, and some Hepworths as Skipworth. Hepworth is a regular surname, with one of its centres in Cambridgeshire and the Fens. By tracing a family group through several census one can often untangle these errors.

No attempt has been made to follow the descendants of married daughters, though I would be happy to include a link if such details have been published elsewhere.

I acknowledge the generous help I have had from other family members and apologise for the fact that it has not always been practical to identify their particular contributions. ## Locality Map



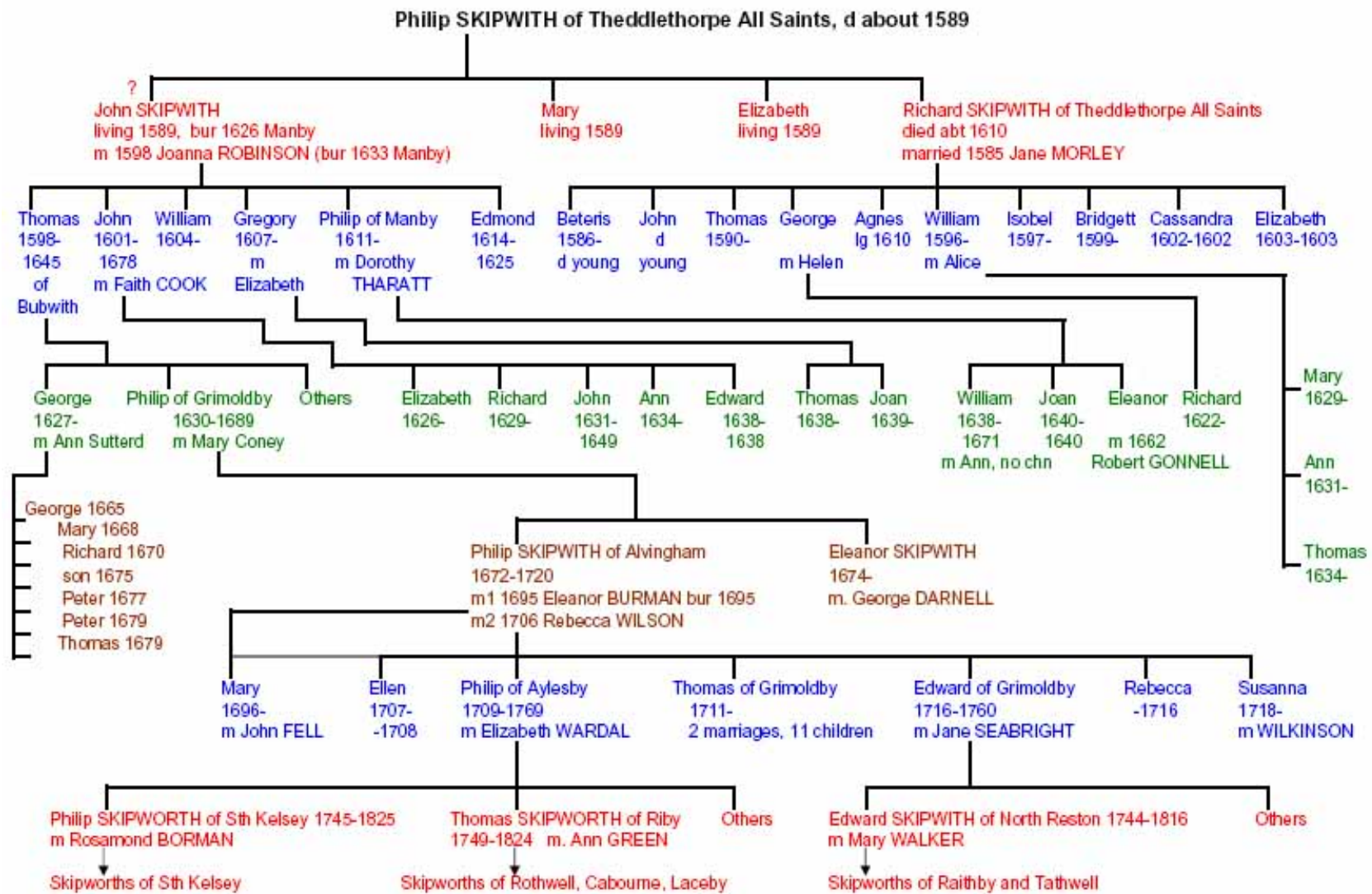
Scale: The area shown is approx 30 kilometres square

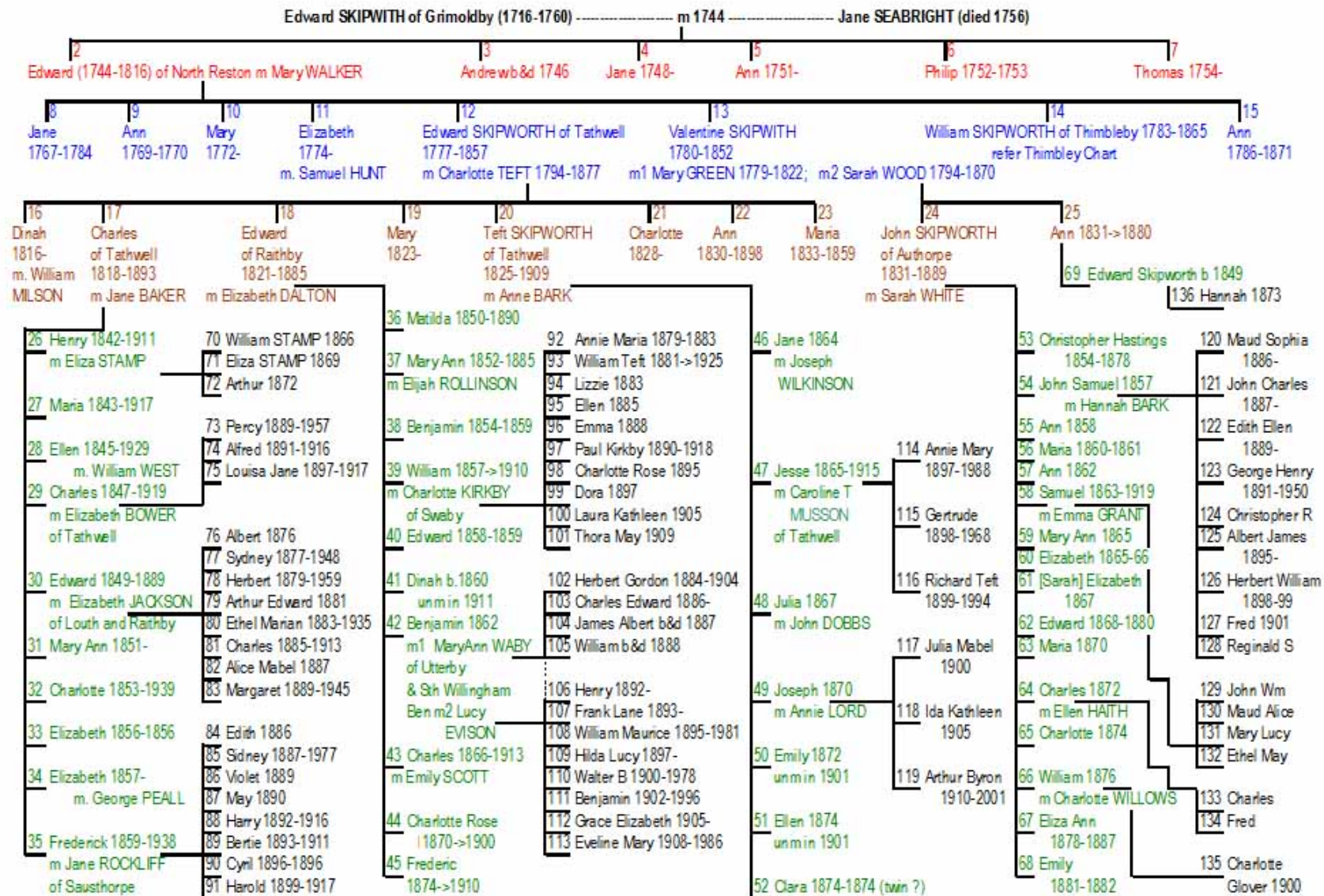

# Descendants of Edward Skipworth of Grimoldby

## *First Generation*

1. **Edward SKIPWORTH of Grimoldby**, son of **Philip SKIPWORTH of Alvingham** and **Rebecca WILSON**, was christened on 7 Sep 1716 in Alvingham, Lincolnshire <sup>1</sup> and died in Grimoldby in 1760 <sup>2</sup> at age 44.

Edward was only four years old when his father Philip died in 1720, leaving his mother with 4 or 5 young children. Necessity dictated that a new father should be found to support them, and Rebecca remarried about a year later to Andrew DUNHAM. They continued to live at Alvingham, almost certainly at Philip's Abbey Farm, where they had two more children. In her will made in 1734 [full text in Appendix 1], Rebecca, by then widowed for a second time, left thirty pounds each to three of her Skipworth children and twenty pounds each to her two Dunham children, the difference acknowledging the contribution of Philip's estate.

Philip had died intestate, but a detailed inventory of his possessions has survived, showing a total value of £253-04-08. On Rebecca's death, his eldest son, another Philip whom I refer to as Philip of Aylesby, took over the farm with its stock and chattels. In monetary terms his inheritance amounted to the £253 from his father's inventory, less the £90 reserved for his siblings, with perhaps some augmentation from the period between his father's and his mother's deaths. His teen-aged siblings would have remained on the farm until each in turn married and established their own homes.

The advantage of being the eldest son can be gauged from the wills of the brothers Philip and Edward in the next generation. Philip's unmarried daughter received £150, while Edward's children each received £5. The discrepancies in the inheritances of their eldest sons was almost certainly much greater, Philip's heir was to establish himself as a gentleman and significant landowner, with power and influence in that part of the county, while Edward's heir was a small tenant farmer. A century later, Philip's heirs owned about 6000 acres and were entering the professions, while the more successful of Edward's heirs were tenants on 20 - 30 acres, and many of them were agricultural labourers and domestic servants.

Edward described himself as a husbandman of Grimoldby when he made his will on 2nd November 1759.

*..... Calling to mind the mortality of my body, and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, [I] do make and ordain this my last will and testament thas to say: I give and recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it, and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried, nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the almighty power of God, and as touching such worldly estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life, I give and dispose of the same in the following manner and form: Item: I give to my four children five pounds each to be paid when they come to the age of twenty-one years each. And Thomas Skipworth and Andrew Dunham to be guardians for them .....*

Edward made his mark instead of signing, on 2 November 1759, which probably indicates illiteracy, though it was common at that time to make a will when death was quite close with the testator barely capable of signing. The handwriting shows that the preliminary statement had been prepared in advance of the detailed instructions, so was probably not Edward's wording at all. The guardians were his brother and his stepbrother. The term husbandman meant someone who operated a farm, with the implication that he worked his [leasehold] land himself. The will was proved in Lincoln Consistory Court in 1760.

He must have been very close to death as it was only a week later that his goods were being appraised for his inventory (page 7). It shows that he was worth £100 less (41%) than his father, or put another way that he owned 43 animals compared with his father's eighty nine. This was the accepted outcome for a younger son, unless he was fortunate enough to marry an heiress.

Jane died on 7 Jan 1756 in Grimoldby.<sup>141</sup>

**2. Edward SKIPWORTH of North Reston** (*Edward of Grimoldby*<sup>1</sup>) was christened on 24 Feb 1743/44 in Grimoldby<sup>5</sup> and buried on 7 Apr 1816 in North Reston, Lincolnshire.<sup>7</sup>

1760: mentioned in father's will

1816: age 72 in burial record

Edward married **Mary WALKER** on 8 May 1766 in Grimoldby Parish Church.<sup>5</sup> The marriage was also recorded at Gainsborough Presbyterian. Mary was born about 1741, died in 1828 (of Authorpe) aged 87, and was buried on 26 Jun 1828 in North Reston.<sup>7</sup>

**3. Andrew SKIPWORTH** (*Edward of Grimoldby*<sup>1</sup>) was christened on 30 Nov 1746 in Grimoldby, and was buried on 13 Dec 1746 in Grimoldby.<sup>5</sup>

**4. Jane SKIPWORTH** (*Edward of Grimoldby*<sup>1</sup>) was christened on 12 Feb 1747/48 in Grimoldby.<sup>5</sup>  
mentioned in father's will 1760

**5. Ann SKIPWORTH** (*Edward of Grimoldby*<sup>1</sup>) was christened on 16 Apr 1751 in Grimoldby.<sup>5</sup>  
mentioned in father's will 1760

8. **Jane SKIPWORTH** (*Edward of North Reston*<sup>2</sup>, *Edward of Grimoldby*<sup>1</sup>) was christened on 15 Feb 1767 in Grimoldby,<sup>5</sup> and was buried, aged 17, on 15 Aug 1784 in North Reston.

9. **Ann SKIPWORTH** (*Edward of North Reston*<sup>2</sup>, *Edward of Grimoldby*<sup>1</sup>) was christened on 15 Aug 1769 in Legbourne, Lincolnshire,<sup>6</sup> and was buried on 30 Oct 1770 in Legbourne<sup>6</sup>.

10. **Mary SKIPWORTH** (*Edward of North Reston*<sup>2</sup>, *Edward of Grimoldby*<sup>1</sup>) was christened on 7 Feb 1772 in Legbourne.<sup>6</sup>

11. **Elizabeth SKIPWORTH** (*Edward of North Reston*<sup>2</sup>, *Edward of Grimoldby*<sup>1</sup>) was christened on 19 Oct 1774 in North Reston.<sup>134</sup>

1861: age 86, aunt, widow, fundholder, living with nephew John Skipworth at Authorpe

Elizabeth married **Samuel HUNT** of Legbourne in 1810 in North Reston.<sup>8</sup>

12. **Edward SKIPWORTH of Tathwell** (*Edward of North Reston*<sup>2</sup>, *Edward of Grimoldby*<sup>1</sup>) was christened on 27 Apr 1777 in North Reston<sup>134</sup> and buried on 4 Aug 1857 in Tathwell, Lincs.<sup>26</sup>

1824: signed the Bishop's transcripts for Tathwell as churchwarden

1841: age 60, of Dovendale House, Tathwell, farmer wife 6 children

1851: age 73 born South Reston, cottager 33 acres at Tathwell

1857: age 81 at death, of Tathwell

Edward married **Charlotte TEFT**, daughter of **Charles TEFT** and **Dinah PACEY**, on 8 Aug 1816 in Raithby.<sup>8</sup> Both made their mark in the Parish Register. Edward was "of Maltby in this parish", Charlotte of South \_\_\_\_\_ parish, married by licence, witnesses Andrew Larder, William Baines. Charlotte was christened on 7 Jan 1794 in Alvingham<sup>1</sup> and was buried on 20 Oct 1877 in Tathwell (aged 84 in burial record).<sup>142</sup>

Charlotte's census records: 1841 age 45, 1851 age 56,

1861 age 66 born Alvingham, widow and farmer 28 acres,

1871 age 80, born Alvingham, mother, widow, living with Edward and Elizabeth at Raithby.

13. **Valentine SKIPWORTH** (*Edward of North Reston*<sup>2</sup>, *Edward of Grimoldby*<sup>1</sup>) was christened on 27 Feb 1780 in North Reston,<sup>134</sup> and was buried on 13 Jun 1852 at age 72 in Authorpe, Lincolnshire.<sup>7,9</sup> His name suggests he may have been born on St Valentine's day, 14<sup>th</sup> February.

1805: [age 19] Bastardy recognizance date 28 Oct 1805, mother Sarah WALKER of Walesby. Putative father Valentine SKIPWORTH of West Rasen, servant in husbandry. Edward Skipworth of North Reston was his surety.<sup>108</sup>

1808: age 22 when he married Mary GREEN at West Rasen

1831: age 51 when he married Sarah WOOD at Authorpe

1841: age 60 ag lab Authorpe with Sarah, John, Ann

1851: age 71 farm lab, pauper, living at Authorpe with Sarah, daughter Ann, grandson Edward, and granddaughter Sarah Wood age 3 (presumed to be from Sarah's first marriage)

## Descendants of Edward Skipworth of Grimoldby

Valentine had a child in a relationship with **Sarah WALKER** in 1805.<sup>108</sup>

On 16 May 1808 Valentine married **Mary GREEN** in West Rasen.<sup>8</sup> Mary was born about 1779, died in 1822 in Authorpe, and was buried on 4 Jul 1822 in North Reston,<sup>113</sup> age 43 of Legburn in burial record (guessed identification).

On 31 Mar 1831 Valentine married **Sarah WOOD** (widow) in Authorpe.<sup>8</sup> Sarah was born about 1794 in Hareby, Lincolnshire, and was buried on 17 May 1870 in Authorpe.<sup>7</sup> In 1861 after Valentine's death she was living with her grandson Christopher (aged 6) at Authorpe. By the time of her death at age 76 she was living in Louth workhouse.

**14. William SKIPWORTH** (*Edward of North Reston<sup>2</sup>, Edward of Grimoldby<sup>1</sup>*) was christened on 28 Sep 1783 in North Reston.<sup>134</sup> Refer to file *Skipworths around Horncastle* for descendants of this William.

**15. Ann SKIPWORTH** (*Edward of North Reston<sup>2</sup>, Edward of Grimoldby<sup>1</sup>*) was christened on 26 Feb 1786 in North Reston,<sup>134</sup> and was buried on 22 Oct 1871 in Authorpe.<sup>7</sup>

1851: age 65 born North Reston, retired servant, annuitant, living with her sister and brother-in-law Samuel and Elizabeth HUNT at Authorpe

1861: age 76, born North Reston, living with nephew John at Authorpe, as was also her sister Elizabeth HUNT, age 86.

1871: age 88 living with her nephew John at Authorpe. The census has her born at Authorpe, but that may be an error, easily made when the rest of the household were from Authorpe..

### Fourth Generation (Great-Grandchildren)

**16. Dinah SKIPWORTH** (*Edward of Tathwell*<sup>12</sup>, *Edward of North Reston*<sup>2</sup>, *Edward of Grimoldby*<sup>1</sup>) was christened on 25 Dec 1816 in Raithby cum Maltby, Lincolnshire.<sup>10</sup> She probably died in 1855, in Horncastle RD.<sup>143</sup>

1841: May have married William Milson, ag lab, as a granddaughter Charlotte Milson aged 5 born Raithby was living with Edward and Charlotte in 1851. Her sister Ann aged 12 servant with them at Gayton le Marsh 1841.

1861: No sign of Dinah, Ann Skipworth living with William Millson, ag lab at Wragby, as his housekeeper.

Dinah married **William MILSON** in 1839.<sup>14</sup> They had a daughter Charlotte.

**17. Charles SKIPWORTH** (*Edward of Tathwell*<sup>12</sup>, *Edward of North Reston*<sup>2</sup>, *Edward of Grimoldby*<sup>1</sup>) was born on 12 Dec 1818,<sup>22</sup> and christened on 3 Jan 1819 in Raithby cum Maltby<sup>10</sup> and died on 2 Feb 1893 in Louth RD, UK<sup>11</sup> at age 74. He was buried at Tathwell.<sup>113</sup>

1841: farmer at time of his marriage

1871: schoolmaster, land surveyor and postmaster [White's directory]

1871: age 52, national schoolmaster, living at schoolhouse Tathwell with Jane wife, 3 chn

1881: age 62, land surveyor and postmaster, living at Post Office Tathwell, with Jane, 3 chn

1891: aged 72, at Tathwell with Jane

From a Featherby Family History by Brian Peter BOND (found on the web but probably a printed pamphlet.):

Henry Chaplin rebuilt Tathwell House in 1842 and two years later erected a school for the local children. The school operated until 1974 when it closed due to declining enrolment. The local vicar reported to the Bishop of Lincoln about Tathwell school in 1855: "It is to be lamented that in agricultural districts both boys and girls are withdrawn from school at so early an age as to preclude any extension or improvement".

Charles married **Jane BAKER** on 14 Dec 1841 in Tathwell, Lincolnshire.<sup>12</sup> Jane was christened on 10 Jan 1819 in Little Steeping, Lincolnshire<sup>25</sup> and died on 11 Feb 1905 aged 86.<sup>215</sup>

Jane was a dressmaker in 1841, prior to her marriage.

1901: age 81, farmer and head of household, son Charles and daughter Elizabeth with her.

**18. Edward SKIPWORTH of Raithby** (*Edward of Tathwell*<sup>12</sup>, *Edward of North Reston*<sup>2</sup>, *Edward of Grimoldby*<sup>1</sup>) was christened on 17 Jun 1821 in Tathwell<sup>10</sup> and again on 19 Dec 1821 in Raithby.<sup>10</sup> He died in 1885 in Louth RD, Lincolnshire<sup>15</sup> at age 64.

1841: age 18 at home with parents

1851: age 29 born Raithby, at Tathwell

1861: age 40 born Tathwell, living with wife and mother at Tathwell

1871: age 50 born Raithby, ag lab at Raithby with wife Elizabeth, 5 children, also mother

1881: age 60, born Raithby, ag lab with wife and 4 children at home

1885: age 65 at death

Edward married **Elizabeth DALTON**, daughter of **Godfrey DALTON** and **Mary**, in 1850 in Louth RD.<sup>16</sup> Elizabeth was christened on 13 Aug 1826 in Kelstern,<sup>40</sup> and died in 1917 in Louth RD.<sup>216</sup>

Christening for Elizabeth Dalton at Kelstern matches the info she provided on the census.

### Appendix 1 Will of Rebekah DUNHAM of Alvingham

*In the Name of God Amen, I Rebekah Dunham of Alvingham in the County of Lincoln, Widow being Sick and Weak of Body but of Sound and Perfect Mind and Memory praised be God for the same Do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner following: First I bequeath my Soul into the Hand of Almighty God hoping through the alone Merits and Mediation of my Blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ to have forgiveness of all my Sins. Also I give my Body to be decently buried at the Discretion of my Executor hereafter Named; And as to my Worldly Goods wherewith God has blessed me*

*First: I give unto my Son Thomas Skipwith the Sum of Thirty Pounds to be paid him within twelve Months of my Decease. Also I give unto my Son Edward Skipwith the Sum of Thirty Pounds to be paid at the Age of twenty one Years. Also I give unto my Daughter Susanna Skipwith the Sum of Thirty Pounds to be paid her at the Age of Twenty One Years and also the Green Bed and full bedding thereunto belonging. Also I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Dunham the Sum of Twenty Pounds to be paid her at the Age of Twenty One Years and also the Blue Bed and full bedding thereunto belonging in the Matted Chamber. Also I give unto my Son Andrew Dunham the sum of Twenty Pounds to be paid him at the Age of Twenty One years. And in case any one of my said Children dye before their said Portion become due I order that the said Legacy be Equally Divided amongst all the Rest of their Surviving Brothers and Sisters both Skipwiths and Dunhams. And I will that the said Legacys, besides what was left each of them by their Respective Fathers, be paid in full without any deduction, and the said Children be maintained in all the Necessaries by my Executor so long as they continue to live with him or their Legacys become due. Also I give unto my son Philip Skipwith All the Rest and Residue of my Money Goods and Chattels and Appoint him Whole and Sole Executor of this my Last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this Sixteenth day of October in the Eighth Year of King George the Second, And in the year of Our Lord 1734.*
